ELIGIBILITY: Open (this is a club match, scores will not be sent to CMP and no awards will be

presented)

REGISTRATION AND SQUADDING: 10:00am on the 200yd line. All competitors must complete registration before 10:30 to receive a relay and target assignment. Competitors wishing to share the same rifle will be accommodated whenever possible. Entries accepted to range capacity prior to the first relay each day. Match director reserves the right to modify match program at any time until firing begins.

RIFLE: A complete list of approved rifles is provided in the *CMP Games Rifle and Pistol Competition Rules* 5.2.2, 5.2.3, 5.2.4 and 5.2.5.

Competitors must use semi-automatic military rifles from the US or foreign manufacture, or Commercial rifles of same type and caliber for the following matches:

- 1. AR-type rifles in caliber 5.56 mm or .223 for Modern Military Category A
- 2. Other US or foreign rifles in any caliber not exceeding 8 mm for Modern Military Category B
- 3. M1 Garands not meeting specifications of "as-issued" in Unlimited Garand

NOTE: This match is primarily intended as a practice modern military match for Camp Perry Participants. All competitors firing Garand/Springfield/Military rifles (Rule 4.2) are welcome to participate.

AMMUNITION: Any safe ammunition may be used in accordance with CMP Competition Rules for Service Rifle and Service Pistol Rule 4.3.3.

SQUADDING: All matches will be squadded.

SCORING: Competitors will pull targets other relays. Match will be shot in 2 relays competitors will self-

score.

CHALLENGES: None

MATCH SCHEDULE:

Sunday June 30th firing begins at 11:00am

Matches 1, 2, and 3

Course of Fire: As-Issued Military Rifle Match Course A (Rule 4.5, Table 3). All stages are fired at 200 yards on the SR target.

Stage 1 - Prone, slow fire, 5 sighter shots and 10 record shots, 15 minutes

Stage 2 - Prone from standing, rapid fire, 10 shots, 80 seconds

Stage 3 - Standing, slow fire, 10 shots, 10 minutes

AWARDS: No awards will be given.

<u>DIRECTIONS TO THE RANGE:</u> The ORSA range is located on the Oak Ridge Turnpike (State Route 95) 3.5 miles west of the intersection with Illinois Ave. (State Route 62) and the Turnpike. The range entrance is the first road on the left after stop light no. 16 at Nebraska Ave.
