LOCATION: Oak Ridge, Tennessee – ORSA High Power Competition Range

RULES: NRA High Power Rifle Rules, Revised June 2011, Chapter 3, apply.

ELIGIBILITY: Open (This is a club match. Scores will not be sent to the NRA and no awards will be presented).

FEES: \$5

REGISTRATION AND SQUADDING: 9:00 A.M. on the 600-yard line. Squadding for the March 3rd match will be conducted in the clubhouse. All competitors must complete registration before 9:30 to receive a relay and target assignment. Entries accepted to range capacity prior to the first relay. Match director reserves the right to modify match program at any time until firing begins.

RIFLE: This match is open to high power Service Rifle, Match Rifle, Long Range and F-Class competitors. Competitors desiring to fire Garand, Springfield, or Vintage Sniper rifles are welcome to participate.

NOTE: This match is primarily intended as a practice match. The objective is for participants to have fun competing with like-minded competitors.

AMMUNITION: Any safe ammunition may be used in accordance with NRA Competition Rule 3.1.

SCORING: Competitors will pull targets for the other relay. Match will be shot in two (2) relays; competitors will self-score.

CHALLENGES: None

COURSE OF FIRE: Firing will commence at 10 A.M.

Match 1 – 600 yards, slow fire, prone, unlimited sighters and 20 shots fired in a 22-minute time limit

Match 2 – 600 yards, slow fire, prone, unlimited sighters and 20 shots fired in a 22-minute time limit

Match 3 – 600 yards, slow fire, prone, unlimited sighters and 20 shots fired in a 22-minute time limit

ENTERTAINMENT: None

DIRECTIONS TO THE RANGE: The ORSA range is located on the Oak Ridge Turnpike (State Route 95) 3.5 miles west of the intersection with Illinois Ave. (State Route 62) and the Turnpike. The range entrance is the first road on the left after stop light #16 at Nebraska Ave.
