OUTDOOR 2700 PISTOL MATCHES**

**Dates:**, JUNE 16, AUGUST 18, SEPTEMBER 15, OCTOBER 20

**Sponsored by:** Oak Ridge Sportsmen's Club.

**Range Location:** Oak Ridge Sportsmen's Association Oak Ridge, Tn.

. The ORSA range is located on the Oak Ridge Turnpike (State Route 95) 3.5 miles west of the intersection of Illinois Ave. (State Route 62) and the Turnpike. The range entrance is the first road on the left (south) past stoplight No. 16 at Nebraska Ave.

**Entry and fees:** Entry fee is \$10.00 per 900 aggregate. Package entry, including NRA registrations is \$15.00; Seniors (over 60) \$15.00). Junior entry fee is one-half fee. Preference will be given to complete program entries and to pre-registered shooters on a first-come basis. Entries are limited to one relay of 12 competitors. Advance entries are encouraged. Excess entries will be notified.

**Firing Starts:** Firing will commence at 9:00 a.m.

**Rules:** Current NRA Pistol Rules will apply.

**Match Course:** (see below)

**Targets, Scoring and Challenges:** Competitors will hang their own targets (B2 and B3), score and replace. All strings of fire will be scored after 10 shots. Use of overlays is permitted. Use of plug type scoring gages will be restricted to range personnel and members of the Jury. The fee will be \$1.00 per challenge, returnable if upheld.

**Classifications:** NRA classifications will be used. NRA Pistol rule 19 inclusive. Unclassified shooters will be placed in the Master Class except those who have an assigned classification under rule 19.14.

**General Information:**

No alcoholic beverages are permitted on the range.

**Awards:** NRA award points or cash will be made to the overall aggregate winner, winners of each 900 aggregate and winners of each match. First place class awards will be made if there are 3 competitors in the class, and second place awards if there are six competitors in a class.

Separate class awards will be given in reserve and/or service categories if there are three competitors in each category. There will be a single service category if there are less than six competitors in both categories.

Approximately 50% of the entry fees will be returned to the competitors in the form of awards. However, we reserve the right to base the awards schedule on the actual number of competitors present.

### **Match Course of Fire (2700 Aggregate):**

#### .22 Caliber Matches

- Match 1: 20 shots Slow Fire at 50 yds
- Match 2: National Match Course
- Match 3: 20 shots Timed Fire at 25yds
- Match 4: 20 shots Rapid Fire at 25 yds
- Match 5: .22 Caliber Aggregate

#### Center Fire Matches

- Match 6: 20 shots Slow Fire at 50yds
- Match 7: National Match Course
- Match 8: 20 shots Timed Fire at 25 yds
- Match 9: 20 shots Rapid Fire at 25 yds
- Match 10: Center Fire Aggregate
- Matches #11 through #15 .45 caliber (same format as .22)
- Match #16 Grand Aggregate (combination of Matches 5, 10 and 15)
