LOCATION: Oak Ridge, Tennessee - ORSA High Power Range

**RULES**: This is a two-man team match where each competitor will fire the President's Course of Fire (CMP HP Rule 5.3 Table 3, page 48). Competitors will be paired-up using a random coffee can draw.

**ELIGIBILITY**: Open (This is a club match. Scores will not be sent to the CMP).

FEES: Waived

**REGISTRATION AND SQUADDING**: 10:00 A.M. in the clubhouse. All competitors must complete registration before 10:30 to receive a relay and target assignment. Entries accepted to range capacity prior to the first relay. Match director reserves the right to modify match program at any time until firing begins.

**RIFLE**: Service Rifles used must comply with CMP Service Rules 4.1.1, 4.1.2, 4.1.3 and 4.1.4 pages 33-38 in the current edition of the CMP HP Competition Rulebook.

**NOTE**: The objective of this match is for participants to have fun competing with like-minded competitors. This is the last coordinated match of ORSA's 2019 shooting season.

**AMMUNITION**: Any safe ammunition appropriate for the rifle being used rule 4.4.1. No tracer, incendiary, armor piercing, or penetrator steel core ammo may be used. All ammunition to be furnished by the competitor.

TARGETS: SR, SR3, and MR1 targets

**SCORING**: Competitors will pull targets for other relays.

**CHALLENGES**: None

**COURSE OF FIRE**: This is a 30-shot match with no sighters. Firing will commence at 11 A.M.

Stage 1; 10 shots standing slow fire, 200 yards, 10 minutes per competitor. Stage 2; 10 shots prone from standing rapid fire, 300 yards, 70 seconds. Stage 3; 10 shots prone slow fire, 600 yards, 10 minutes per competitor.

**ENTERTAINMENT**: Final scores

**DIRECTIONS TO THE RANGE**: The ORSA range is located on the Oak Ridge Turnpike (State Route 95) 3.5 miles west of the intersection with Illinois Ave. (State Route 62) and the Turnpike. The range entrance is the first road on the left after stop light #16 at Nebraska Ave.
