Mon-Sat 9am to Dusk, Sun Noon to Dusk

SAFETY GLASSES AND EAR PROTECTION ARE REQUIRED ON ALL ORSA RANGES
When moving to the line, ensure firearms are unloaded and cased or holstered.

Do not touch firearms if RANGE COLD lights are flashing.

ABSOLUTELY NO CENTER FIRE RIFLE ROUNDS

- 1. TREAT ALL FIREARMS AS IF LOADED AT ALL TIMES.
- 2. KEEP MUZZLE POINTED IN A SAFE DIRECTION AT ALL TIMES.
- 3. KEEP FINGER OFF & AWAY FROM TRIGGER UNTIL ABSOLUTELY READY TO SHOOT.
- 4. KEEP FIREARM UNLOADED UNTIL READY TO SHOOT <u>OR</u> IF RANGE SAFETY LIGHTS ARE ON.
- 5. NEVER POINT ANY FIREARM AT ANYTHING YOU ARE NOT WILLING TO COMPLETELY DESTROY.
- 6. DO NOT TOUCH YOUR FIREARM OR ANY OF ITS PARTS WHEN RANGE SAFETY LIGHTS ARE ON.
- 7. NO FULL-AUTO OR TRIGGER ACTUATORS <u>OF ANY KIND</u> SIMULATING FULL-AUTO ARE ALLOWED.
- 8. NO TARGETS OR CLIMBING ON BERMS.

AUTHORIZED Firearms and Ammunition

Rim fire handguns, rim fire rifles, shotguns, center fire handguns in traditional pistol cartridges.

ABSOLUTELY NO CENTER FIRE RIFLE ROUNDS

Range Safety Light System

PRIOR TO GOING DOWN RANGE:

CALL "CEASE FIRE - RANGE COLD"

- 1. MAKE ALL FIREARMS SAFE AND CLEAR WITH ACTIONS OPEN.
- 2. REMOVE MAGAZINES, SAFETY ON IF SO EQUIPPED, AND INSERT EMPTY CHAMBER INDICATOR.
- 3. TURN FLASHING LIGHTS ON.
- 4. ABSOLUTELY NO HANDLING OF FIREARMS, MAGAZINES OR OTHER PARTS WHEN PERSONNEL ARE DOWN RANGE AND FLASHING LIGHTS ARE ON.

TO GO HOT

- 1. ENSURE ALL PERSONNEL ARE BEHIND FIRING LINE.
- 2. DON EYE AND EAR PROTECTION.
- 3. TURN FLASHING LIGHTS OFF, CALL "RANGE HOT".

Authorized Targets

Plastic bottles, metal cans
Caliber specific metal targets
Paper targets on boxes or frames
Tennis & Golf Balls, Baseballs

<u>USE COMMON SENSE – PLACE TARGETS AT LEAST 20 FEET AWAY</u> TO MINIMIZE HAZARDS FROM FLYING FRAGMENTS AND RICOCHETS.

Prohibited Targets
NO AERIAL TARGETS
NO EXPLODING TARGETS
No Glass or items that contain glass or electronics
No Political signs
ALWAYS clean up after yourself & others
