## **2020 Oak Ridge Sportsman Associations' “Bat Soup Regional”**

**This will consist of 3 matches over the course of  
Friday-Sunday, June 5, 6 & 7, 2020  
Registration 0800 Hours/First rounds at 0900 Hours  
on all days**

**June 5th: 4 man team match (NMC 50 shots w/ sighters)**

**June 6th: Across-the-Course match (80 shots w/sighters)**

**June 7th: Civilian Marksmanship Program 50 shot EIC Match, all CMP  
rules apply**

**(Yes, a real “leg” match, just like we weren't able to shoot at Camp Perry this year, so don't complain about our paltry entry fees, since you'll be saving all that money you'd have spent on gas and beer!)**

## **Being thoughtful, we shall follow these COVID-19 related guidelines:**

- **Our firing line has 30 firing points; we will only be using every other firing point.**
- **Registration for Sat-Sun events will be capped at 48 shooters with preference going to out of town shooters. Attendees MUST preregister (payment not required) for us to manage the numbers of shooters.**
- **If you are sick, have been sick, have been around anyone who is sick, please do not show up to shoot or spectate.**
- **We will be providing hand sanitizer and Clorox wipes, please use them**
- **We will use a modified score card/scorekeeper system on Fri-Sat to minimize scorecard transfers**
- **Registration and squadding will take place in the metal building just behind the 600 yard line, NOT in the CLUBHOUSE**
- **Please practice appropriate social distancing**
- **The use of medical PPE (mask, gloves, self-contained environment suit, etc.) is up to the shooter**

If you are already Distinguished and want to shoot the EIC match, please let me know. Non-Distinguished will receive first priority.**

**Match Fees (to be collected at time of registration/squadding):**

**Friday's team match: \$10 per shooter**

**Saturday's match: \$20 per shooter (NOT a registered match, since the NRA is closed)**

**Sunday's EIC match: \$25 (adults)/\$15 (juniors)**

**We are planning to have food after the Saturday match, and are working out the details. Hopefully this will not consist of us throwing an MRE into your open driver's window as you leave for the day!**
