LOCATION: Oak Ridge, Tennessee - ORSA High Power Range

RULES: Current NRA High Power Rifle Rules apply

ELIGIBILITY: Open (**This is a club match**. Scores will not be sent to the NRA and no awards will be presented).

FEES: \$20

REGISTRATION AND SQUADDING: 8:00 A.M. at the 600 yd. line. All competitors must complete registration before 8:30 to receive a relay and target assignment. Match director reserves the right to modify match program at any time until firing begins. Team format with random draw for teammates at squadding

RIFLE: NRA Rules 3.1, 3.1.1, 3.1.2, 3.1.3 or 3.3 in Matches 1-5

SIGHTS: Metallic or optical sights as specified in NRA Rule 3 allowable in matches1-5.

AMMUNITION: NRA Rule 3.17a&b, furnished by the competitor.

TARGETS: SR, SR3, and MR1 targets will be used.

SQUADDING: All matches will be squadded.

SCORING: Competitors will pull targets for other relays.

CHALLENGES: A fee of one Dollar will be charged in advance for each challenge.

(40 Shot NMC Sighters Course of Fire, No Sighters). Firing will commence at 9 A.M.

Match 1 – 200vds, slow fire, standing, 10 shots per team member, 20 minutes

Match 2 – 200yds, rapid fire, standing to seated or kneeling with a magazine change, 10 shots per team member, 60 seconds

Match 3 – 300yds, rapid fire, standing to prone with a magazine change, 10 shots per team member 70 seconds

Match 4 – 600yds, slow fire, prone, 10 shots per team member, 20 minutes.

Match 5 – Aggregate of scores fired in Matches 1-4.

ENTERTAINMENT: There will be a cookout at the clubhouse following match completion. All participants are invited to attend.

DIRECTIONS TO THE RANGE: The ORSA range is located on the Oak Ridge Turnpike (State Route 95) 3.5 miles west of the intersection with Illinois Ave. (State Route 62) and the Turnpike. The range entrance is the first road on the left after stop light #16 at Nebraska Ave.
