

Oak Ridge Sportsmen's Association Civilian Marksmanship Program 2024 Excellence in Competition (EIC)

Sunday April 7, 2024 Sunday June 2, 2024 (w/Charlie Smart Regional)

LOCATION: Oak Ridge, Tennessee. The ORSA range is located at 2625 Oak Ridge Turnpike (State Route 95), 3.5 miles west of the intersection with Illinois Ave. (State Route 62). The range entrance is the first road west of the stop light at Nebraska Ave. Bear right through the gate and proceed straight over the hill to enter the Charlie Smart High Power Range.

ELIGIBILITY: Open. Competitors who have not previously fired in either CMP or NRA high power rifle competition are encouraged to complete at least one CMP Basic Rifle clinic before firing a CMP EIC event at ORSA.

RULES: These matches follow the CMP EIC format. Current CMP Competition Rules and ORSA club rules will apply and it is the competitor's responsibility to be familiar with all rules therein. <u>CMP</u> <u>Highpower Rifle Competition Rules (2024) 27th Edition</u> is available online at <u>http://thecmp.org/competitions/cmp-competitions-rulebooks/</u>

ENTRY FEE: \$25 adults and \$15 juniors. Entries accepted to range capacity prior to the first relay each day. There must be at least 6 non-distinguished competitors in order to qualify as an EIC match. Priority will be given to non-distinguished shooters. Competitors who wish to shoot out of competition must declare their intention prior to firing their first shot.

REGISTRATION AND SQUADDING: 8:00AM to 8:25AM at HP Range 600 Yard Shed. Firing will begin at 9:00AM.

SCORING AND PIT OPERATION: Competitors will shoot, score and pull targets in a normal three relay operation on the same firing point.

CHALLENGES: A \$3.00 fee is required in advance for each challenge.

MATCH SCHEDULE: 50 shot National Match Course, no sighters or alibis

- 200 yds, Slow Fire, standing, 10 shots, 10 minutes
- 200 yds, Rapid Fire, standing to sitting or kneeling with magazine change, 10 shots, 60 seconds
- 300 yds, Rapid Fire, standing to prone with magazine change, 10 shots, 70 seconds
- 600 yds, Slow Fire, prone, 20 shots, 20 minutes

RIFLES & AMMUNITION: The Matches are fired with Service Rifles (Rule 4.1.1 to 4.1.4). Any safe ammunition appropriate for the rifle being used rule 4.3. No tracer, incendiary, armor piercing, or penetrator steel core ammo may be used. All ammunition to be furnished by the competitor.

CMP ACHIEVEMENT AWARDS: Gold, Silver and Bronze Place medals will be presented to the top three competitors (Distinguished or non-Distinguished) Gold, Silver and Bronze Achievement Pins will be presented to competitors equaling or exceeding Achievement Award Scores. Points are awarded by CMP to any non-Distinguished who place in the top ten percent of non-Distinguished shooters, provided the score fired by the competitor equals or exceeds the EIC minimum credit score (rule 9.3.7).
